St Ann's Hospice organises many fundraising events throughout the year, including:

- **Manchester Midnight Walk** is an annual 10km walk around Manchester City Centre, which helps us to raise hundreds of thousands of pounds.
- **Go Yellow!** is an annual fundraising campaign that takes place in June, where everyone can take part, with creative fundraising ideas.
- **Tree of Lights** is our annual remembrance service, held each December, which allows people to celebrate the lives of those who have died.
